A sofa after a drawing of Robert Adam and made by John Linnell during the period 1762–1765 for the drawing room at Kedleston Hall. Hand carved and water gilded to match the original in fine detail. This design is one of several designs for the same sofas for the 1st Baron Scarsdale at Kedleston Hall. The sofa took three years to make and arrived in 1765.
