

Robert Adam Breakfront Bookcase

Originally designed by Robert Adam in 1761 and made by John Linnell. The bookcase has a scrolled pediment centred by acanthus spray and flanked with swagged urns with a gadrooned and acanthus carved cornice. The geometric designed glazed doors sit above a mahogany bed with egg and dart carved under-moulding, above a blind fret frieze. Three centre draws below are flanked by three smaller drawers to each side. The deep plinth is carved with acanthus leaf and beading.

Bespoke sizing, design adaptations and finishing available.
